Roles and Responsibilities

1. Objective

To prevent and address any act of ragging within the college and hostel premises as per the guidelines of the **National Medical Commission (NMC)**, **University Grants Commission (UGC)**, and the **Supreme Court of India**. The Committee ensures a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment for all students.



3. Major Roles & Responsibilities

A. Preventive Measures

1. Ensure **strict implementation** of anti-ragging regulations as per NMC and UGC norms.
2. Conduct **orientation programmes and counselling sessions** for new MBBS students and parents during admission.
3. Display **anti-ragging posters and helpline numbers** at prominent locations (college, hostel, library, canteen, etc.).
4. Obtain **anti-ragging affidavits** (as per UGC format) from all students and parents at the time of admission.
5. Conduct **awareness drives** involving faculty, senior students, and hostel staff on zero-tolerance policy.
6. Maintain coordination with **Anti-Ragging Squad** and **Hostel Wardens** to monitor student behaviour.

B. Monitoring & Vigilance

1. Conduct regular **rounds in hostels, canteen, and other common areas**, especially during the initial months.
2. Review reports submitted by the Anti-Ragging Squad on any suspicious or concerning activities.
3. Maintain **confidentiality and protection** of complainants or witnesses in all cases.

C. Complaint Handling

1. Receive and review any **complaint or information** regarding ragging from students, faculty, or parents.
2. Conduct a **fair and prompt inquiry** into the incident with the Anti-Ragging Squad.
3. Record all findings and submit recommendations to the Principal/Dean.
4. Ensure **disciplinary action** in accordance with NMC/UGC regulations and college rules (which may include suspension, expulsion, or FIR if needed).
5. Provide **psychological counselling and support** to victims of ragging.

D. Reporting & Documentation

1. Maintain a **register of complaints and actions taken**.
2. Submit periodic reports to the University/NMC/UGC through proper channel.
3. Update online information on the **Anti-Ragging Portal (www.antiragging.in)** as required.

4. Disciplinary Actions (as per UGC Regulations, 2009)

Depending on the nature and severity of the offence, the Committee may impose:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Debarring from examinations or hostel facilities
- Rustication from the institution
- Cancellation of admission
- Lodging of an **FIR** with local police for criminal proceedings

Coordinate with the Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squads for regular inspection and vigilance.

Maintain communication with the NMC/UGC Anti-Ragging Portal and University authorities.

3. Prevention and Awareness

Organize orientation programs and awareness campaigns for students, staff, and parents.

Display anti-ragging posters, helpline numbers, and rules prominently on campus and in hostels.

4. Monitoring and Reporting
