
Purpose:

Scope:

The Committee shall oversee all pharmacovigilance-related activities within the institution, including but not limited to:

- Encouraging voluntary reporting of suspected adverse drug reactions and medication errors.
- Reviewing, evaluating, and documenting ADR reports received from various clinical departments.
- Facilitating the submission of ADR reports to designated pharmacovigilance authorities and monitoring centers.
- Promoting awareness and education on drug safety among faculty, residents, nursing staff, and students.
- Organizing periodic meetings to review pharmacovigilance activities and outcomes.
- Advising the institution on matters related to medicine safety, risk management, and regulatory compliance.
- Undertaking any other activities necessary for strengthening the pharmacovigilance system
